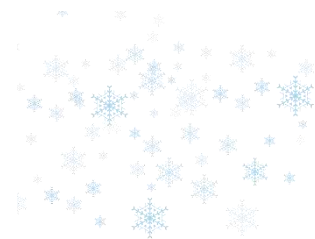

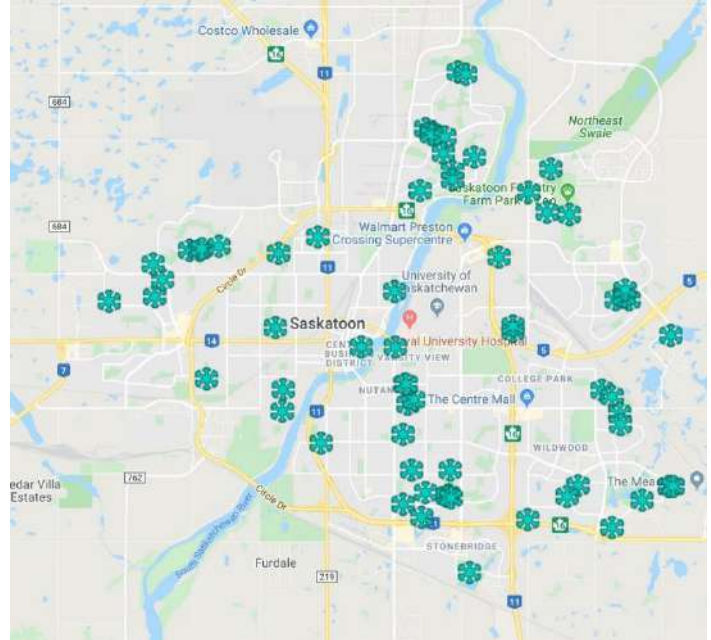

Christmas Light Displays

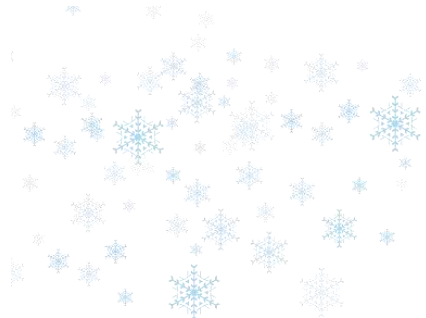
